DIRECTIONS TO BRACKNELL LEISURE CENTRE

There is a large free car park at the centre. There is also a café and bar selling a range of meals and light refreshments.

ACCEPTED SWIMS SUMMARY

All swimmers who entered and paid on time and met the published entry criteria have been accepted.

Please consult the accepted swims summary at www.bsbasa.org for full details of the entry information received from the on-line entry system. Errors to the entry information can normally be corrected before the meet (please email developmentmeet@bsbasa.org). It is most unlikely that corrections will be possible on the day.

SESSION TIMES

The times for sessions 2 and 3 are different to the provisional times published in the promoter's conditions. The revised session times are:

REGISTRATION – INDIVIDUAL EVENTS

All swimmers need to register that they intend to swim in each of the events they have entered for. There will be separate registrations for all sessions. Registration closes at the start of the warm up for each session, ie 9:00 for session 1, 12:10 for session 2, and 15:15 for session 3

Registration will take place at the top of the stairs as you approach the pool. There will be separate registration sheets for boys and girls, and there will be someone to assist. Swimmers need to register their intention to swim by highlighting their competitor number for the events they will swim. Events that they will not be swimming should be left un-highlighted.

If you do not register, you will not be able to swim.

REGISTRATION - RELAYS

Relay team declaration forms will be sent to the person who entered the relay teams. These must be completed with the names of the competitors who will swim and posted in the tray on the announcer's desk before the start of the warm up for the relevant session. If the declaration form is not posted, the team will not be able to swim.

REPORTING FOR EVENTS

It is the responsibility of each swimmer to make sure they report to the competitor stewards in good time for their swim. Start lists will be posted on pool side before the start of each session.

LATE ENTRIES AND TIME TRIALS

We are not accepting late entries, but as the meet is not full we are offering time trials. Time trials will swim in a heat appropriate to their entry time (but not in the last heat). Time trials will not be eligible to win medals. Times achieved will be sent to rankings and can be used to enter other competitions including Counties and Regions. Time trials are only available to those swimmers who were eligible to enter. Entries for time trials must be made and paid for via the on-line entry system. However a special entry link is required. You can obtain a link by emailing developmentmeet@bsbasa.org, giving the ASA number of the swimmer or swimmers concerned. An entry link will be emailed back to you and this can only be used to enter that swimmer. All time trials must be entered into the on-line system and paid for by midnight on Friday 12 October. No time trials will be accepted after that time, or on the day (but see below for relay time trials). The cost of time trials is £6.75. There will be separate registration sheets for time trials, who must register as described above.

We will accept relay time trials on the day. Please see the meet team before the start of the warm up for the relevant session. Relay time trials will costs £8.50.
